## REACH COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

The European REACH Regulation (EC No. 1907/2006) is covering the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical Substances. It has been in effect since June 2007. It covers chemicals as such, but also chemicals in articles.

KiiltoClean A/S hereby confirm that our products are compliant with the relevant regulation (EC No. 1907/2006), based on information given by our suppliers. REACH compliance means that all chemical substances in the products we handle:

- Have been pre-registered and/or registered by our suppliers, or they
- Are excluded from the Regulation, or exempted from registration

KiiltoClean A/S is a downstream user of chemicals, and it is our responsibility to ensure that we use the chemicals according to the registration and to check that our suppliers meet the requirements of the REACH Regulation (EC No. 1907/2006).

According to REACH Article 33 there is a duty to communicate information on substances in articles:

1. *"Any supplier of an article containing a substance meeting the criteria in Article 57 and identified in accordance with Article 59(1) in a concentration above 0,1 % weight by weight (w/w) shall provide the recipient of the article with sufficient information, available to the supplier, to allow safe use of the article including, as a minimum, the name of that substance."*

These substances are called SVHC = Substances of Very High Concern.

KiiltoClean A/S will continue to monitor the SVHC Candidate list to make sure none of the components in our products contain any substances above 0,1 % w/w listed in the SVHC-list published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

The pertinence of the above-mentioned information is continuously checked by us, if any change happens or new information comes up, our customers will be informed immediately.
